Generate And Teach Health Equity Routinely™
from the Washington Chapter of the
American Academy of Pediatrics

WHY:

This quarterly learning collaborative focuses on improving health equity through three, 1.5 hour peer conversation sessions with providers from across Washington State. Participants will learn to improve their practice of EDI using a quality improvement framework, self-assessment, and peer discussion.

WHO:

All Washington State pediatric health care providers, including pediatricians, family physicians, nurses, and Advanced Practice Providers.

With the use of quality improvement, self-reflection and peer discussions, GATHER continues to demonstrate improvements in medical staff's EDI practice and behaviors.
